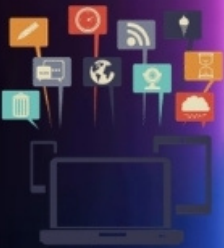

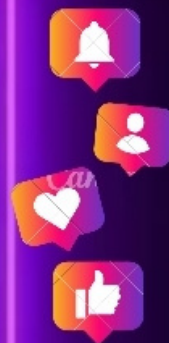

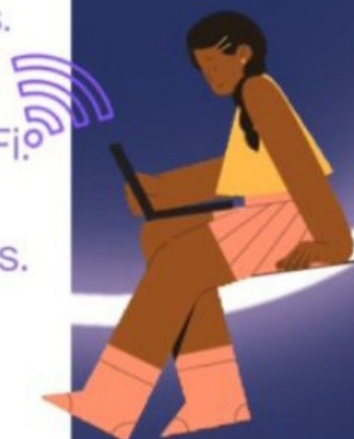
- S**et strong and unique passwords

- A**ct promptly if you suspect any suspicious activity on your accounts
- R**efrain from sharing personal information
- I**nform yourself on how to protect your data
- N**ever download software or apps from untrusted sources
- Y**oga for your digital well-being: take breaks from screens and care for yourself
- T**urn on automatic updates for your software
- E**valuate reviews and sources before making online purchases
- R**ecognize harmful or abusive online behaviors
- E**ver leave devices unattended in public places
- N**educate yourself on recognizing scams and fake news
- E**ntertain others with respect online

8 Report inappropriate content immediately

9 Never share your passwords

Spam emails may seem innocent at first, but they are always a gateway for malware or data theft.

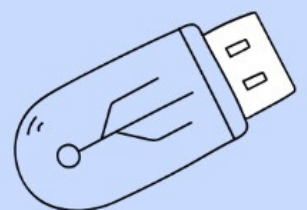
Phishing

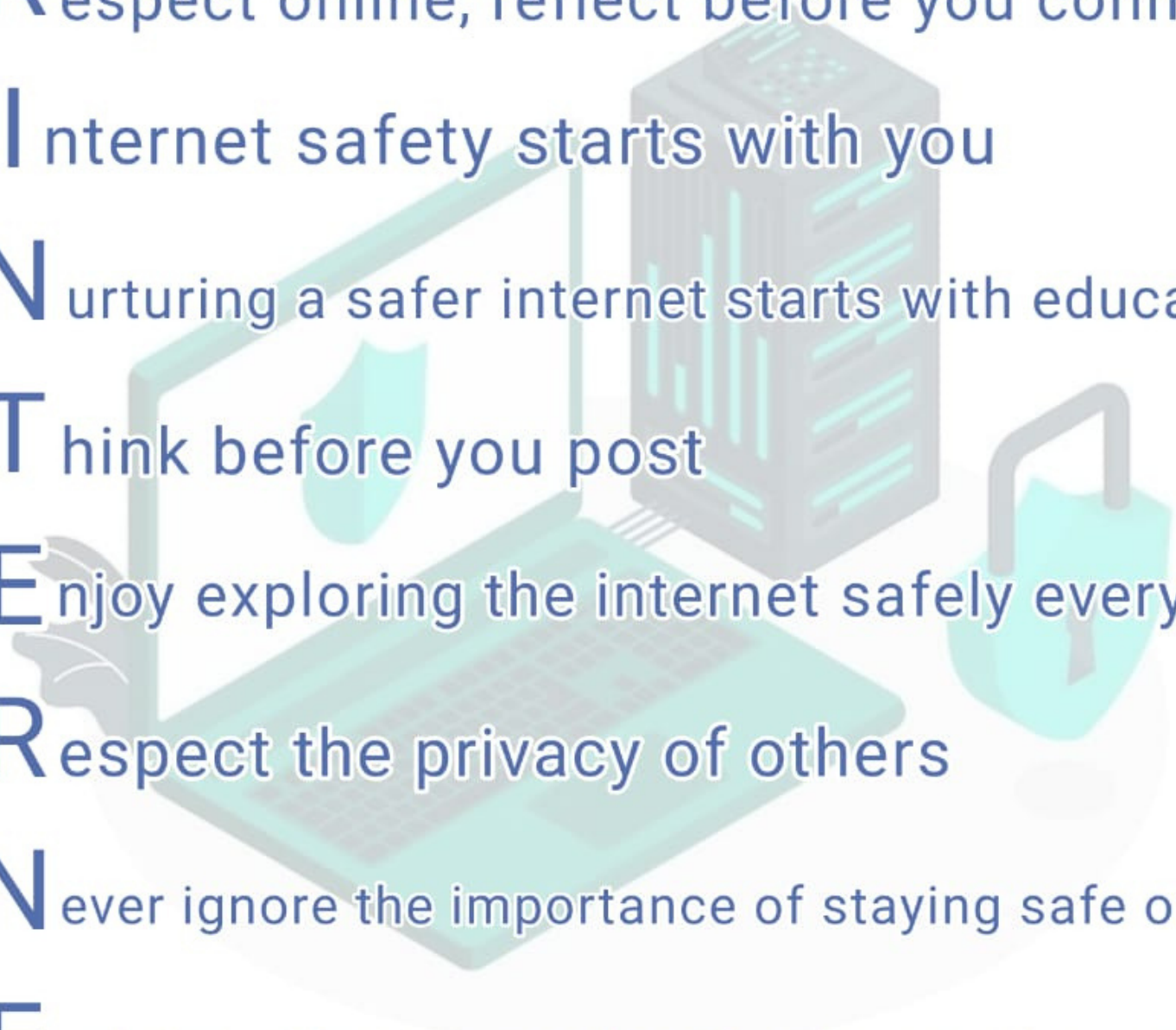
